Jason is busy with Disco Inferno set to do any more work at Finlayson St, but also that he cannot do any more until the leak in the roof is fixed. Joel said it is looking fantastic.

Stiff auditions will be on the 6th November in the Hatea Room. Disco Inferno publicity in hand.
